VOLLEYBALL

1. **Rules:** This competition will be conducted under the rules of the Fédération Internationale de Volleyball except as modified by the Arctic Winter Games International Committee as noted in Section 6.

2. **Categories:**

- a) Junior Male: born in 1988 or later
- b) Junior Female: born in 1988 or later

3. **Events**

Tournament Competition – see standard schedule package

4. **Team Composition:**

Junior Male	-	10
Junior Female	-	10
Coaches	-	2

If qualified coaches are available, one must be female and one male.

The following athletes are considered elite and therefore ineligible to compete.

- Members of the Canadian National Junior Volleyball Team,
- Any athlete that has competed for any nation in the World Championships,
- Any athlete that has ever held a senior card as defined by Sport Canada

5. **Medals:** Individually by team:

6. Arctic Winter Games Rule Modifications

- a. In the event of a tie after the round robin/preliminary portion of the tournament, the following will be used to determine team positions for the finals:
 - a. The team(s) with more game wins for the entire round robin/preliminary portion of the tournament shall be placed ahead of the team(s) with fewer game wins.
 - b. If teams are still tied after (a), then the result of the round robin game(s) between the tied teams will apply. The team(s) with the higher number of game wins between the tied teams will be placed higher.
 - c. If the teams are still tied after (a) and (b) then the result of the round robin game(s) between the tied teams will apply. The team(s) with the greatest point differential number of games between the tied teams will be placed higher.
- b. If a team misses a match it will forfeit that match but will be allowed to continue in the tournament. The match results will be scored 'X' Games to 0 ('X' being the minimum number of Games required to win a match). The score for each game in these matches will be recorded as 'Y' Points to 0 ('Y' being the minimum number of points required to win a game).
- c. Seeding – Each team's number will be based on a random draw once the teams have been confirmed in each category.
- d. The game ball will be as follows:
